GATHERING

✤ Light a candle to help you focus this time as "God time."

✤ Prayer of the Week

God, as you opened the Scriptures to your disciples on the road to Emmaus, open them also to us so that we might learn of the life you have promised all who follow you. Amen.

CARING CONVERSATION

Take a moment to check in with each other or to use the questions below.

- Highs and Lows: What was something that was boring today? What was something that was interesting or exciting?
- Thinking about This Week's Story: Jesus taught his disciples while they were travelling. What was one thing you learned today? Did you teach anyone anything?
- Getting Ready for Next Week's Story: Next week, the apostles select leaders to make sure everyone's needs were met. How were you helped today? How did you help someone else?

DAILY BIBLE READING

Read aloud from the DAILY BIBLE READING from the front. What do you want to remember from this reading?

PRAY TOGETHER

CLOSING

 \clubsuit If you used a candle, extinguish it as a sign of the end of the devotion time.
